Butt or sand rolls which are used to judge quality + are then scrapped, are inspected on O.T. on an equal share basis between the ^{1st} inspector + Union inspector, separate lists are maintained.

On S.T. either inspector may do it depending upon their ^{time} availability + depending upon the Id. Inspector not getting additional O.T. because he was inspecting butt rolls + S.T. + thereby had to complete his own regular work on O.T.

On regular rolls which are returned from customers, the lead inspector handles this.

Union claims that on S.T. only the Union Inspector can run sample rolls on the unwind for inspection. Claimed Foreigner agrees.
