Form OD-4 is herewith submitted at the request of the claimant.
It is signed by the claimant and by the employing company.

The claimant previously filed a claim for a respiratory condition due to
silicosis given No. OD-47978. This claim was eventually disallowed
on the reason that the claimant was not totally disabled.

The claimant has continued to be employed by this company, but during the
past year he has been doing limited types of light work principally
as a janitor.

The company agrees that his physical condition is such that he is unable
to do more than light employment and is of the opinion that he will
continue in employment with the company. It, therefore, would
be proper in stating and deciding this claim, particularly have the claimant
presented to the Board of Silicosis Referees to determine whether or not
this is a result of an occupational disease.
