3. Heading - Electric Furnace

Customer has complained of asbestos in our inserts have arranged simultaneous tests of the same boards and found asbestos in our material that is supposedly asbestos-free. Explained contamination due to use of other products, have explained also that we now do not use asbestos in any of our plants. Further shipments will be investigated to insure this to be the case.
