2 A Correct, yes, sir.

3 Q Okay. I think at your deposition you told
4 me that based upon your review of the deposition
5 transcripts you would estimate the number of brake
6 work or brake jobs that would have been done in the
7 1948 to '52 time period as somewhere between three to
8 nine a day at the Preston Street garage.

9 Does that sound --

10 A That sounds right.

11 Q I gather there is a range because there is
12 some uncertainty as to exactly how many went on a
13 day?

14 A Yes, sir. It was 50 years ago.

15 Q Okay. But three to nine would be a pretty
16 fair sample?

17 A Yes, sir.

18 Q Okay. And I think both at deposition and at
19 trial both Mr. Carter and Mr. Butler testified that
20 there were approximately 150 vehicles at the Preston
21 Street garage that they worked on.
