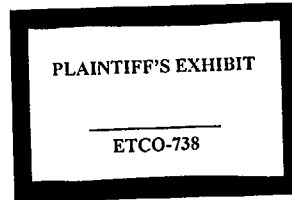

SUBJECT Worker Exposure to Asbestos

In view of the results of the recent inspection of our R&D Maintenance Shop by OSHA personnel, where possible exposure to asbestos fibres was suspected due to cutting of transite, packing, etc., or any other asbestos containing compounds, it is requested that each of you again survey your areas and submit a list where you feel that there may be a potential exposure to asbestos fibres. There may be no problem, but, under the law, any possible place of exposure must be monitored to determine that fact.

Please give this matter your prompt attention and return your list to me by June 1, 1973.
