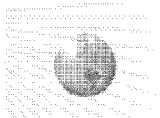

grant for \$250,000 for Dr. DePierre at Stockholm University. Basically the work is on immune system interactions and interactions affecting lipid metabolism. The aim is to put the immune effects story to rest, and get a better understanding of the mechanisms of interaction between PFOS and lipid pathways. This would include work on ion pairing in a second year if the grant is extended.

There are several attachments you may want to peruse in John's note. Larry W is ok, but not enthusiastic about this (you may want to discuss with him). I am fully supportive because we need this relationship with a solid European scientist, in addition to benefiting from the work.

This is of course funded out of the FC budget, and we can pay the initial 250 yet this year - it will probably be tighter next year, so we are thinking it is a good idea to do this now.

I am always available for discussion, as is John, if needed.
