

WINS DAMAGE SUIT

Hubbard Gets \$60,000

Verdict for Loss of Eye

Bennettsville, Dec. 9.—H. H. Hubbard, Sr., who has sight of one eye and part of the other, losing eight years ago, was tonight awarded actual damages of \$60,000 by a Marlboro county jury against Standard Oil Company of New Jersey.

The case took four days to reach the jury, which agreed on a verdict after two hours' deliberation. Judge John I. Cosgrove of Charleston presided in the absence of Judge C. G. Featherstone because of the latter's illness. There were eight attorneys for the defense and four for the plaintiff. Numerous witnesses from both sides from North Carolina and Ohio. *State*
