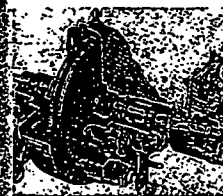

Most turbine users have the same reasons for choosing Elliott:

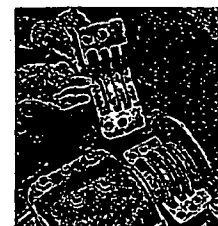
1. Parts interchangeability. Standardization between frame sizes of most wearing parts. For example, two sizes of bearing liners will fit five YR turbine frames.
