SUBJECT

VERMONT - OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY & HEALTH STANDARDS

In reply to your letter on the above subject, I have the following information:

1. The State of Vermont does have a Safety Health bill which enables Vermont to comply with OSHA.
2. It is known as VOSHA (Bill #6174) and was approved March 31, 1972.
3. According to Mr. James Maroneau (Executive Vice-President) of the Associated Industries of Vermont, the State of Vermont does not intend to apply the OSHA standards to the Mining Industry in the State.
4. They will apply OSHA standards only if the Bureau of Mines lose their power of inspection at the federal level.
5. Mr. Maroneau has been asked to serve as an advisor to the Commissioner of VOSHA. He intends to accept and will represent industry in all matters pertaining to OSHA.
6. Should the State consider a change in its position, Mr. Maroneau will notify me at once.
