14 A 36, 37, 38, 39. Well, it would have
15 been from -- part of it appears to come from
16 the same, from the attachment to the, to the
17 letter.

18 Q Okay.

19 A The reason I say that is the current,
20 the current intelligence bulletin is numbered
21 36. Next page is numbered page 2, but in
22 parentheses, it says 37.

23 So it appears somebody was putting a
24 package together of which the NIOSH stuff was
25 page, began with page 36, and other things were
