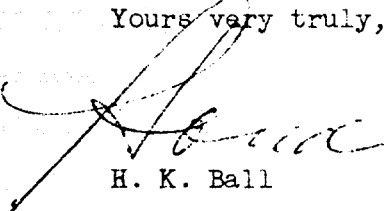
Dear Hume:

We have noted your letter of September 30th regarding Mr. E. R. Erskine's contact with the subject company regarding handling of AK-33X. As you know, for the present, and until we receive advice to the contrary from Dr. Kehoe, AK-33X is to be handled exactly the same as "Ethyl" fluid or TEL. The same precautions should be followed. It definitely should not be handled the same as benzene.

Do you know whether or not Dr. R. A. Sharp signed the customary release when AK-33X was supplied to him?

We are passing copies of your reports along to Dr. Kehoe in Cincinnati and Dan Guy in Detroit and we do feel that if Dr. Sharp is not going to go along with our recommendations that any requests for future supplies should be withheld until he better understands the problem.
