I do not feel I am in a position to counter requirements that Hoerner Waldorf's OSHA inspector is apparently requiring. If he requires the four items stated in Carlson's letter, then I suppose that is what they will have to do.

With regard to our plant experience, we have had to (1) conduct special physical examinations, (2) provide protective clothing, (3) purchase vacuum equipment, and (4) meet the 5 fibers per cc. fiber count as outlined in the regulations.
