Please note the attached letter from Dr. Telfair. This is the only answer received at this time from our inquiry. As other answers are received they will be passed on to you.

It would seem that either the Thiophen-free Benzine or the M-Xylene would be satisfactory for standardization of your cells. As the cell constants may be accurately determined by your equipment, any differences in the observed and true characteristics may reflect to the condition of the cell plating or cleanliness of this cell.

Please note that their lead capacitance is subtracted as a "blank".

In the event that trouble is experienced in the "power-factor" determinations, perhaps it would be well to exchange samples with Dr. Telfair.
