Dick Hunt should not be present but Unwin thought that he could be of some help in contacting Montgomery and Brown and if you wish, Gallagher, to set a mutually convenient meeting date, hopefully in mid-July.

Following this meeting and after you get a feel as to what the Government position might be, then individual companies could be brought in for a later meeting, if this is found to be desirable or necessary.

Unwin suggests that you call Hunt on Tuesday, July 6, and touch base with him.



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
