Your letter to Mr. Henry S. Thompson has been handed over to me, and I am sending you two more sets of the various lead studies which have already been published. There are several more papers to appear as well as a large monograph, and I will send them to you when they have been published. Dr. G. W. Thompson of the National Lead Company informs me that he has forwarded to you the third report of the three years investigation, so that I am not including this.

Unfortunately I am not able to send you a complete file of the reprints because there are no more of one of them - #8 - which describes a micro-chemical method of detecting small quantities of lead. This, however, is again described in the monograph.
