

NOTE: Reporting is not required for waste that is excluded from regulation. See 40 CFR Parts 261.4, 261.5, 261.6, 261.7, 262.11, 264.1, and 265.1. Examples: Waste treated in totally enclosed treatment facility, elementary neutralization unit, etc..

- Line 2 - Description of Waste - For listed wastes (See Appendix, 40 CFR Part 261, Subpart D), enter the EPA listed name, abbreviated as necessary. For unlisted wastes (See Appendix, 40 CFR Part 261, Subpart C), enter the appropriate characteristic term and the contaminant where appropriate. Add your own description when you feel it is needed for clarification.
- Line 3 - On Hand, On-site on January 1, 1985 - Enter the amount of self-generated waste, regardless of when generated, (expressed in tons to the third decimal place) that was on your property on January 1, 1985. (Waste placed in a disposal unit is considered disposed, not stored, and should not be shown on Line 3.) (NOTE: The numbers you enter in the boxes should be as far to the right as possible in all cases so that they may be easily added.)
- Line 4 - Generated During 1985 - Enter the total weight of the waste or waste mixture that you generated during the calendar year 1985.
- Line 5 - Total Amount for Which to Account - Enter the sum of Lines 3 and 4.
- Line 6-9- Shipped to: - Enter the EPA I.D. Number and Name of the waste handler to whom the self-generated waste was sent for treatment, storage, disposal, reshipment, use, reuse, recycling, or reclamation. Enter the amount of the waste. Use a different line for each waste handler.
- Line 10 - Treated On-site - Enter the amount of self-generated waste treated on your property during the year.
- Line 11 - Treatment Code - Enter the code that best describes the manner in which the waste on Line 10 was treated. Select from the following:

<u>CODE</u>	<u>DEFINITION</u>
T01	Treatment, tank
T02	Treatment, surface impoundment
T03	Treatment, incinerator
T04	Treatment, other

- Line 12 - Disposed of On-site - Enter the amount of self-generated waste disposed of on your property during the year.
