& Western S/S Co.'s Steamer "West Isleta", which sailed

We confirm night message of even date giving
you this information.

You will note this steamer sailed from
Philadelphia on March 25th. We were not aware however
that Beeder, Adamson & Co. had shipped any goods for our
account on this steamer, until we received Bills of Lading
from them this morning.

They failed to send us copies of invoices
at the time shipments were made, consequently we had no
means of knowing that goods were on board.

We have called their attention to this
matter and they promise to see that invoices are mailed
to us promptly, in future.
