Brothers, Sisters See Boy Drown

LAKEPORT, Sept. 5. — While his three brothers and two sisters watched in horror, a 14-year-old El Sobrante boy drowned here today.

He is Ervin Russell Connes Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Ervin Russell Connes of 5168 Argyle Road. Firemen and Pacific Gas and Electric Company employees worked vainly for two hours to revive him.

According to Lake County Coroner Robert A. Kinleyside, the Connes family arrived here this morning for a three-day outing. The parents left the youngsters at the city pier at the foot of Third Street shortly after noon, telling Ervin and his older sister, Jean, 16, to watch the four others. The parents then returned to their camp to pitch a tent.

Ervin jumped from the pier into 15 feet of water. Ivy Spears, of Bakersfield, who was sitting nearby, saw him flounder and go under, and jumped in to make a rescue attempt.

Bystanders called Bob Pringle of Napa, a lifeguard who dived for the body and recovered it after 10 minutes.

Witnesses to the tragedy included the dead boy's sister Jean and a second sister, Christine, 2, and three brothers, Paul, 13, Charles, 9, and David, 8.

Fifth Store Bombed In Kansas City
