Cutting Off Water Ruled Extortion

BERLIN, May 16 (AP). — The practice of many landlords of shutting off the water supply of tenants unable to pay their rent has been declared by the courts of Danzig to be a form of extortion and therefore punishable by law.

A precedent was established at the trial of a shoemaker, Herr Stechow, who had shut off the water supply of some of his tenants. The tenants were in arrears because almost their entire income had been attached by the court for other outstanding debts. The prosecuting attorney described Stechow's procedure as "a most reprehensible form of blackmail," and the court sentenced the landlord to a fine of 100 gulden or two weeks in jail.

Yosemite Routes In Good Condition

Roads to Yosemite Valley were reported today by the California State Automobile Association as generally in good condition. Work on the All-Year Highway is being handled so that motorists experience but little delay. This road is in excellent condition and is holding up well under heavy travel.

Grading, widening and filling of ruts on the Wawona road has been under way for some time. The Big Oak Flat road is in excellent condition to Car Inn and it is expected to be opened beyond this point at an early date.

On August 28, 1731, the steeple of St. Peter's church tumbled with a loud crash, pierced the roof and two floors of an adjacent house, and landed in the basement.

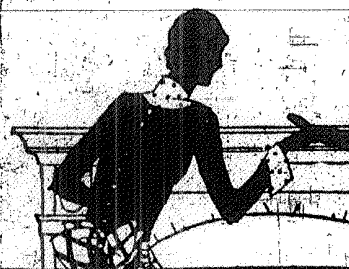
PICKFORD DIVORCE
