been used before to repair skull fractures. But the older technique was to lay the plate on top of the unbroken bone and sew it onto the skull remnants with metal thread.

The surgeons at Walter Reed said the older method sometimes resulted in the formation of an unsightly hump, due to the fact that the metal was raised above the normal contour of the skull. And they said plates that were sewed onto the top of the bone sometimes slipped, necessitating further surgery.

In the new method, the plate rests on ledges chiseled out of solid bone, so that the top of the metal is flush with the skull. Moreover, the surgeons said, the use of the tiny metallic wedges (also of tantalum) which are hammered into the bone at an angle through the plate, makes for greater firmness than heretofore.

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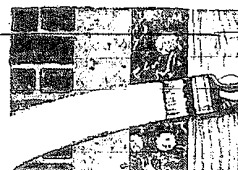
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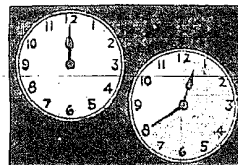
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
