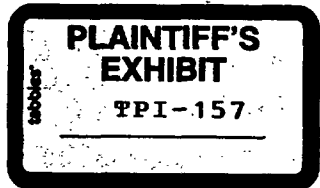

SUBJ: Asbestos Complaint Inspection

On April 26, 1979, I received a call from Mr. Jack Matthews, Industrial Hygienist with OSHA, concerning our recent inspection. He had received the results from the asbestos sample taken in the North Plant Core Room Maintenance Shop. The personal sample that was taken came out to be 0.2 fibers per cubic centimeter (f/cc). No fibers were found in the area sample and the lab detection limit is 0.08 f/cc.

The 0.2 f/cc was on a sample of approximately 20 minutes. An 8 hour weighted average would be well below the standard 2 f/cc and below 0.1 f/cc which requires a Doctors examination yearly.

Mr. Matthews said we would probably not receive anything in writing, except possibly two recommendations. They are as follows:

1. Proper disposal of scrap and used asbestos.
2. Protective clothing for the individual cutting the asbestos.

Both of these recommendations have been put into effect.
