I discussed blood lead results of 7/7/71 and 7/16/71 with Mr. Biel, of MacGregor Lead Company. A total of 12 blood leads were taken on the two dates from 9 employees. Compared to results of bloods taken 6/16/71 and 7/2/71 five employees had lower lead levels and four higher lead levels.

I discussed the need for continued vigilance of all employees, particularly their personal hygiene while on the job and the wearing of respirators. Also I reiterated our confidence in the Willow Island laboratory. I pointed out the fact that we had run a long series of checks in the past and would be more than willing to do so again. Mr. Biel agreed that this might be considered. I said I would contact Dr. Falk and discuss this with him.

I called Dr. Falk. He had received six blood lead reports from Dr. Conlon at the West Allis, Wisconsin Hospital. All but one were lower than our Willow Island results. This one was higher.

It was decided to have Mr. Nagy, Willow Island, call Dr. Conlon direct and discuss their respective methods in order to discover the reason for the different results.

Mr. Nagy was contacted and will call Dr. Conlon.
