Microscopic:

S61-1522: Sections of the lip show erosion, ulceration, chronic inflammation and a focal area where strands of stratified squamous epithelium extend below the mucous membrane into adjacent tissue. The epithelial cells vary in size and shape and form small epithelial pearls.

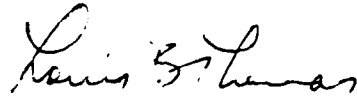
S72-3348: Another section of lip which shows only hyperkeratosis.

S73-1920: Sections show typical features of gynecomastia with ducts lined by hyperplastic epithelium, sometimes exhibiting intraluminal papillary tufts.

S73-4690: There are fragments of carcinoma cells in the sections of the block of the pleural exudate.

Diagnoses:

1. Superficial squamous cell carcinoma, lip.
2. Hyperkeratosis, lip.
3. Gynecomastia.
4. Carcinoma cells in pleural fluid.
