TOLAN TELEGRAM

Senator Breed announced he had received a telegram from John Tolan Jr., secretary to Congressman Tolan, urging the adoption of a re-apportionment program which would expand the Seventh District, now represented by Tolan.

The Seventh District now comprises the 16th, 17th and 18th assembly districts according to the reapportionment bill under discussion in the Senate. The district embraces downtown Oakland, Piedmont, Emeryville, Albany and Berkeley.

Tolan's message was interpreted as a desire to include Contra Costa County in the seventh congressional district, separating it from the sixth congressional district, which is now represented by Albert F. Carter.

Breed said he could see no reason for taking Contra Costa County away from the sixth district and handing it over to Tolan, particularly in the absence of any demand from the Contra Costa County residents.

RELIEF BILL. Action on the long-delayed unemployment relief bill was scheduled for today in the Senate, when Senator John Phillips will present the report of the committee which has been ironing out differences between Senate and Assembly views on the bill.

Approval of the report is expected from both houses of the legislature. The bill will then go to the Governor, who has already announced his intention to veto the measure, which eliminates the State Relief Administration and hands over to county boards of supervisors the authority to administer relief funds in their own districts.

5850,000 Low Bid On Sunnyvale Project

The San Francisco Housing Authority said today Barrett and Hilgert submitted a low bid of \$850,000 for the proposed administration building for the Sunnyvale housing project.

The two-story reinforced concrete structure will also house maintenance shops, a community hall seating 400, the health center, nursery school, and handicraft rooms.
