match their sleeping comfort.

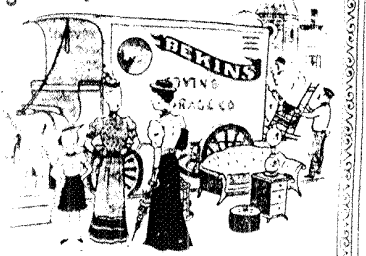

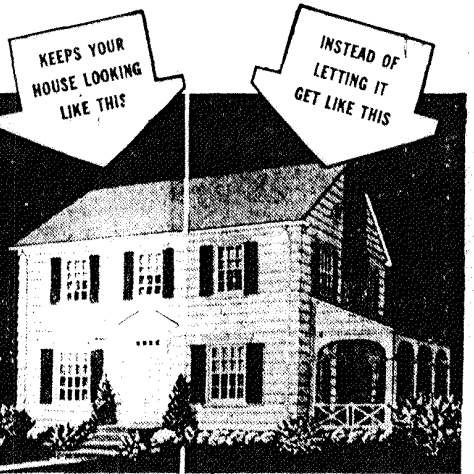

## 'Hurricane Factory' Unveiled; 750-Mi. Blast to Test Planes

Wind Tunnel at California Institute of  
Technology Cost \$2,500,000

PASADENA, May 13.—(AP)—Cal Tech unveiled a \$2,500,000 new hurricane factory today.  
It's the southern California co-  
operative wind tunnel, a giant steel duct shaped like an oblong doughnut and capable of generat-  
ing a 750 mile an hour blast, as fast as sound. It will be used to test scale models of new air-  
plane designs.  
California Institute of Tech-  
nology completed the tunnel in a little more than three years for Consolidated Vultee, Douglas, Lockheed and North American Aircraft Companies, which paid for it.  
This isn't the biggest wind tunnel ever built. Outside dimen-  
sions are 179 by 72½ feet—but it boasts several distinctions.  
One is its decompression sphere, which makes possible the changing of plane models in the tunnel without destroying the atmospheric pressure.  
[To test some models it is necessary to develop four times atmospheric pressure; to whip the 750 mile an hour storm, the air will be evacuated down to perhaps 1/10 atmospheric pressure.]  
In using the decompression sphere, a solid steel airtight gate is lowered on each side of the testing area. This seals in the pressure or vacuum in the remaining nine tenths of the tunnel. An eighteen foot steel door on the side of the tunnel is then opened by hydraulic mechanism. Plane models can be changed, and the tunnel put back in operation in a few minutes.  
Innovations also are the movable model tables on which the model planes are wheeled into the test chamber.  
Reactions of plane models are recorded in a nearby room that looks like a wizards' den with its rows of calibrated dials, wall banks of flashing numbers and automatic printing machines that stamp out slotted index cards and typed records at the push of a button. These were a special job done for the tunnel by International Business Machines Corp.  
The project is directed by Dr. Clark Blanchard Millikan, hands-on son of Dr. Robert Andrews Millikan, Nobel prize winning physicist who heads Cal Tech. A similar tunnel is under construction at Buffalo, N. Y., by Curtiss Wright Corp.

## ALLERGY LINKED TO INHERITANCE

ALBANY (N. Y.), May 13.—Allergy to ragweed or other things is a "matter of inheritance," stated Dr. Kenneth E. Crounse, in charge of the allergy clinic at Albany Hospital, in a Science Forum.  
The allergic tendency is inherited by some members of allergic families, but the symptoms will not necessarily be the same in all members nor is the cause always the same. A child born in an allergic family will probably show some disturbance before it is 10 years old. On the other hand, if only one parent comes from an allergic family, the child may be 10 years or older before symptoms appear.  
Not all children inherit the tendency even in families that are allergic to the stimulant.
