- 2022 RAISE, Waialae Road Extension. Roadway redesign project that includes bike lanes.
- 2023 RAISE, Ala Wai Bridge. Pedestrian and Bike bridge project.
- 2023 RAISE, Liloa Dr Extension. Roadway redesign project that includes shared use path.
- 2024 RAISE, Hilo Bayfront Highway Improvements. Roadway redesign that includes bike lanes. NEPA completed per HDOT.
- 2024 RAISE, Salt Lake Boulevard Complete Streets. Roadway redesign that includes bike lanes.
- 2025 RAISE, West Maui Greenway. Shared use path. Evacuation redundancy near Lahaina wildfire area.
- 2023 SS4A, Keawe Street Improvements. Roadway safety improvements in Maui, includes bike lanes.

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
