Al Harvey has forwarded you a copy of his letter dated January 18, 1978, on the subject of talc labeling.

When you start this program you will be hand stenciling the bags and it probably is not possible to apply the caution label to every bag. We believe it will be acceptable for an interim period to stencil several bags on each side of a pallet.

As soon as possible, all new bags coming into the plant will be printed with the caution label. Peter Burr has already been instructed to do this on all outstanding and future talc bag purchases.

For those few special case customers and particularly export customers where the customer may not want the words INDUSTRIAL TALC to appear on the bags, kindly handle each individual case with the appropriate sales manager for a decision.

For record purposes, on the effective date that you begin the talc labeling program, kindly direct a confirming letter to me of the effective date that you started and that all future production of talc will contain the label.
