GRINNELL CORP. - WELDING PAINTED METAL

Part 1518.352 and 353 of the Federal Safety and Health Standard has been redesignated Part 1926.352 and 353. A copy is attached for your information. These standards pertain to ventilation requirements for welding, cutting or heating of metals containing or coated with toxic substances such as lead, zinc, cadmium, chromium or mercury.

It is suggested that you advise Grinnell of the amounts of these materials in 389-172 so that they can take the appropriate steps to conform to the standard.

389-172 contains, as added ingredients, only two of the heavy metals listed in Part 1926.353:

Chromium - 0.42% (on total solids)
Lead - 2.00%
