

1 Q So --

2 A Not from occupational.

3 Q If I understand you correctly, if we have a
4 person who dies from mesothelioma and can never be
5 interviewed and has no family to interview, and we
6 don't know anything about where the person worked, and
7 the pathologist looks at the lung tissue and finds a
8 whole bunch of asbestos in the lungs, more than would
9 be expected from the background, in that situation you
10 would not relate that mesothelioma to asbestos,
11 correct?

12 A Most likely we would say that there would be
13 a potential of occupational exposure. I am not so
14 sure about your hypothetical.

15 It is getting way off the tangent.

16 Q All I am trying to point out, Doctor, that
17 person would be listed as a nonasbestos mesothelioma
18 on the chart, right?

19 A Which person?

20 Q A person who has -- who could not give an
21 occupational history, either because they were dead or
