CORRECTION--HYGIENIC GUIDE
Tetraethyllead (TEL)

All Members who obtained copies of the "Hygienic Guide for Tetraethyl Lead" either from us or from the American Industrial Hygiene Association are asked to note that a correction should be made. The lower limit of the temperatures at which TEL fluid may detonate was incorrectly given as 300°C; the correct figure is 170°C. We suggest that, in your copies of this Guide, the final sentence in the Table of Significant Properties be changed to read as follows: Detonation of TEL fluids may occur at temperatures of approximately 170°C or greater.
