Gentlemen:

O On May 10, 1960 we conducted a survey of your asbestos brake lining and
fanning operations to determine whether these operations were creating a health
hazard and checked the amount of production taking place in each case.

P It was found that the brake lining operation was still in the pilot plant
phase and experimentation was still being conducted on the fanning line. At
this time it did not appear to be a health hazard; however, when these processes
are conducted full time, improved ventilation will be necessary and samples should
be taken to evaluate the hazard more completely. When the plans are available
for the production process for the brake lining, we would appreciate being able
to check over the ventilation provided.
