Dear Doctor Hillenbrand:-

We have received the blood samples which you sent and we have completed the analyses. One sample was analyzed by the Spectrographic Method and the other by the Dithizone Method, the former yielding 0.025 milligrams per 100 grams of blood, and the latter 0.03. These results are in complete confirmation of each other and are also in confirmation of our previous opinion that this man has had no recent significant lead exposure.

The results on the urine samples will be sent to you promptly when they have been completed. I shall be away from the laboratory for several days but the information will be forwarded to you.
