Subject: Vinyl Chloride - CMA

CMA is about to begin a 5-year update Epidemiological study of workers exposed to V.C. Ben Leach has indicated to CMA that Uniroyal Chemical will bear its share of the costs for this study. I am still listed as a member of the overall Program Panel for this study (Phase VIII) and as a member of the smaller V.C. Research Coordinators group. On one hand we are no longer in the V.C. business but on the other, this phase will be concerned with workers who were exposed to V.C. prior to 1974 so will include our Painesville plant workers.
