Dear Mr. Graves:

In reply to your letter of April 27, Mr. Dutcher has initialed and we return herewith Addendum No. 2 to Exhibit A of the contract.

Please note that the cost of 1/2" Insulating Lath at Ft. Dodge is shown as \$39.10 while you had previously shown a cost in the original Exhibit A of \$32.77. Again for this item at Grand Rapids you show a figure of \$40.50 on Addendum No. 2 while the original contract showed \$33.60. We would appreciate an explanation of why these costs are being increased and would of course prefer to adhere to the original figures although it is not of much importance for this slow moving item.

Addendum No. 2 does not show the costs of three more items which we shall certainly need based on a number of orders we have already received. Would you please make arrangements for pricing bedding and topping compound and rolls of 60' tape. In addition to these items, we would appreciate costs for roof deck mix and formboard which we are considering putting in the line at an early date.
