Dear Tate,

Thank you for following up on our request to provide a publicly facing map of Jurisdictional Determinations. The beta tool that you sent along looks like a great start. It is simple but provides sufficient detail for users to know whether a JD has been made and on what basis. My only suggestion would be to include as base layers the national hydrography dataset (<https://nhd.usgs.gov/>) as well as the National Wetland Inventory (<https://www.fws.gov/wetlands/data/Mapper.html>). It would also be very helpful if the determinations were marked as polygons/lines representing wetlands, lakes, and streams rather than as points. This would help users determine if a water on their property has been evaluated and would give co-regulators (states) the ability to integrate these findings with our other programs and spatial tools.

I enjoyed meeting you and Administrator Pruitt last week.
