Dear Mr. Mittnacht:

In my previous correspondence relating to the European situation I neglected one point which I think is of sufficient importance to require immediate attention.

Dr. Machle has called my attention to the fact that within a reasonably short period, it will be necessary to clean some of the storage tanks abroad which have been used with Ethyl Gasoline. This makes it imperative, I believe, for us to circularize the companies involved through the Ethyl Export Corporation, and to call to their attention the special instructions which relate to the cleaning of these tanks. A sufficient supply of cards for this purpose should either be sent to Mr. Bevan or distributed through any other mechanism which seems desirable. I take it that no further assistance will be required from me in this matter, but if you prefer to have me handle it, please instruct me accordingly.
