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X. INTRODUCTION AND SUMMARY OF REGISTER

The Navy Service Plan was inaugurated by the United States Navy early in the year 1942. The General Electric Company adopted the Navy Service Plan during the year 1943 and since that date to 1 July 1952, forty-three (43) General Electric Navy Service Plan Reports had been published. During this period, over seven-hundred (700) vessels had been visited by our representatives. Most of these vessels were classed United States Naval Vessels and the few remaining vessels were classed United States Service Craft.

The scope and purpose of the Navy Service Plan is outlined in BuShip's letter QM/General Electric (641-800) of 27 January 1947 to all Naval Shipyards and Naval Station San Diego with copies to all force commanders.

Sections 2 and 3 of this register lists in alphabetical order the vessels type and in numerical order the vessel's type number. Section 2 concerns Naval Vessels and Section 3 concerns Service Craft. Section 4 lists all of the vessels in Sections 2 and 3 in alphabetical order by the vessel's names. These arrangements are in accordance with Naval Vessels Register Navships 18-1-17 dated 1 July 1952.

In numerous instances, many of these vessels were visited by our representatives in connection with the Navy Service Plan. In other instances, the United States Navy or Military Sea Transportation Service personnel requested the services of our representatives. In both instances, our representatives, with their knowledge and experience of the equipment involved, furnished recommendations or supervised the necessary repairs in order that the equipment aboard these

vessels could be maintained or restored to satisfactory operating conditions.

As mentioned above, 43 Navy Service Plan Reports had been published between the year 1943 and 1 July 1952. Each of these reports cover a time interval of one (1) month minimum to six (6) months maximum. Outlined below is a list of the 43 Navy Service Plan Reports arranged in numerical order and the period covered by each report.

1. EXPLANATIONS

In Sections 2, 3 and 4 of this register, there appears a series of columns containing various headings such as vessels name, type, numbers, etc. In Paragraph 1A, the meanings and purposes of these headings will be explained. In Paragraph 1B, the meanings of many abbreviations used in this register will be explained.

1A. ARRANGEMENT OF INFORMATION IN SECTION 2, 3 & 4

Contained in Section 2, 3 and 4 of this register, there appears a series of columns headed by various nomenclature. In Section 2 and 3, these headings are identical and are explained as follows:

- (a). The first column shows a reference number (REF. NO.). This number identifies each vessel or in some cases, classes of vessel in this Navy Service Plan Register. The asterisk (*) preceding the reference number denotes that the vessel has been stricken from the Naval Vessels Register, Navships 18-1-17 dated 1 July 1952.
- (b). The second column shows the type (TYPE) of vessel as designated by the United States Naval Vessels Register, Navships 18-1-17.
- (c). The third column shows the type number (NO.) of the vessel as designated by the United States Naval Vessels Register, Navships 18-1-17.
- (d). The fourth column shows the present name of the vessel as it appears in Naval Vessels Register Navships 18-1-17, its former status which could mean its former type, types or its Maritime Commission (Now Maritime

Administration) hull number. The slant mark (/) is used to separate the present vessel's name and its former status. In some cases, the former name of the vessel is shown and the former name appears directly below the present name in parenthesis (). The present name of the vessel and its former status is shown in accordance with Naval Vessels Register Navships 18-1-17.

(e). The fifth column shows the shipbuilding yard where the vessel was built.

(f). The sixth column shows the hull number assigned to the vessel by the shipbuilder.

Note: Our records do not contain the necessary information regarding the shipbuilding yards and shipbuilder's hull number (columns 5 and 6, e and f) for some of the vessels listed in this register. When this information is available, it will be included at some later date and the register will be revised accordingly.

(g). The seventh column shows the various Navy Service Plan Reports and unit or units covered by each report for each vessel or classes of vessels.

As an example for an explanation of (g) the seventh column, let us take Reference No. 1 ACM-4 BUTTRESS. The seventh column shows 10 (V). This information means that this vessel is included in Navy Service Plan Report No. 10 and that this vessel was visited (V) by our representative. In another case, for example, 42 (T-EG), the 42 means that the vessel is included in Navy Service Plan Report

No. 42 and that the propulsion turbine T, and generator EG, are the subjects contained in this report. The meanings of the abbreviations in parenthesis are explained in more detail in Section 1B.

The meanings of the headings in Section 4 are explained as follows:

(h). The first column shows the type of vessel and is identical to that shown in Section 2 or 3 and as explained in Paragraph 1A (b) above. The asterisk (*) preceding the type denotes that the vessel has been stricken from the Naval Vessels Register, Navships 18-1-17 dated 1 July 1952.

(j). The second column shows the type number and is identical to that shown in Section 2 or 3 and as explained in Paragraph 1A (c) above.

(k). The third column shows the present name only of each vessel and does not show any former status or former names.

(l). The fourth column shows the reference number of each vessel and is identical to that shown in Section 2 or 3 and as explained in Paragraph 1A (a) above.

(m). The fifth column shows the page number in Section 2 or 3 on which the name of the vessel appears.

1B. ABBREVIATIONS OF INFORMATION IN SECTION 2, 3 & 4

In Section 2, 3 and 4, there appears a series of abbreviations. Under the column headed TYPE, there appears a series of letters which denote the type of vessel as classified by the United States Navy. These abbreviations which are in accordance with Naval Vessels Register Navships 18-1-17 dated 1 July 1952 are outlined as follows:

Under the columns headed "Present Name/Former Status", the former status may appear, for example, as "MC 164". The "MC" is an abbreviation for Maritime Commission which is presently succeeded by the United States Maritime Administration. The number followed by the letters MC is the vessel's number assigned by the presently succeeded Maritime Commission. The former status may also appear as, for example, /CV/CL. These symbols refer to types of vessels and this specific information would mean that the vessel was previously typed or classed as an aircraft carrier (CV) and prior to this classification, the vessel was classed as a light cruiser (CL). In other instances, the former status may also appear as, for example /DD 789. This information would mean that the vessel's former status was a destroyer (DD) number 789.

Under the column headed "Shipbuilding Yard", there appears various abbreviations denoting the shipbuilder's name. Outlined below in alphabetical order are the various abbreviations of shipbuilding yards and their full names. In some cases, the addresses for these yards are also included.
