4 MS. TOSTANOSKI: Could you read the next
5 sentence, please.

6 MR. IGNATOWSKI: It is strongly recommended
7 that at the Kaylo plant a medical program be
8 maintained which would require a preemployment
9 examination, including a roentgenogram of the chest,
10 of all prospective employees and a routine chest
11 roentgenogram of all regular workers at intervals of
12 once each year.

13 MS. TOSTANOSKI: Thank you.

14 MR. IGNATOWSKI: The next is Number 30,
15 Owens-Illinois Number 30 which is a document dated
16 June 1st, 1950 to Mr. W.G. Hazard, Industrial
17 Relations Division, Owens-Illinois Glass Company,
18 Toledo, Ohio.
