As per your instructions to Mr. Rosser over the telephone, we acquainted Dr. Kitzmiller with The Texas Company situation at Tampa.

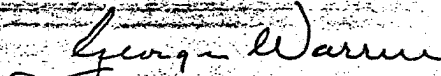
Our Mr. E. T. Smith at Birmingham left at noon Wednesday, November 8th, with Dr. Kitzmiller in his car, and drove direct to Tampa - a distance of approximately 625 miles. I requested Dr. Kitzmiller to wire me just what he found in order that I might pass the information along to Mr. Mittnacht.

From the telegram which we received this morning, copy of which is attached, it would seem that any evidence of triethyl lead poisoning found, is slight.

However, I am writing Mr. Mittnacht today acquainting him with the fact that The Texas Terminal Superintendent, Mr. Hoffecker, violated all his Company's instructions in cleaning out the tank in question. At the same time, I am going to ask Mr. Mittnacht to bring it to the attention of The Texas Company sufficiently forcibly to preclude the possibility of a reoccurrence in any other terminal - whether they be in this territory or some other.

I trust we have been in position to lend your department assistance in this matter.
