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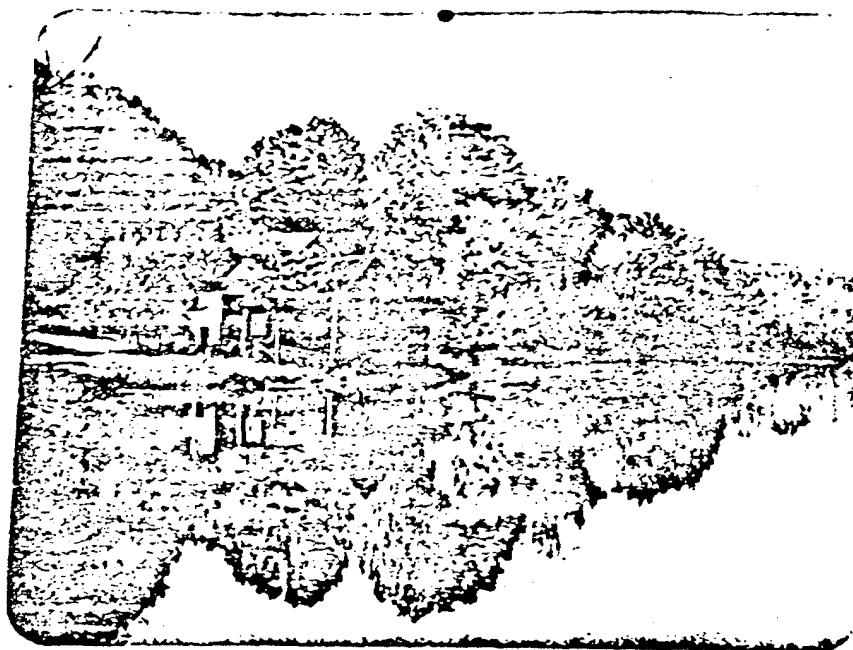

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COOKING TIP

A PRACTICAL RULE for meat cooking. Roasting meat at a low temperature of 300° gives the best all-around results for even roasts. A slow roast is best for flavor development in broiled meats. Too much roasting heat causes shrinkage and loss of flavor.
