HISTORY

Incorporated Illinois April 1947, authorized capital 1,000 shares no par value common stock.

Louis Fishman native born 1914, married. Associated with Rubin Fishman in recap rubber line for five years prior to 1930. 1930 engaged in business in scrap rubber line for five years and in following year consolidated his interest with brother, Peter under style Fishman Bros Co. 1942 during war time emergency program, operations in rubber field temporarily halted by government order. Upon cessation of activities in rubber line, Fishman became active in jobbing of burlap and rags under style of Illinois Textile Co. August 1942, operations resumed in rubber line under style Louis Fishman & Sons, that time. 1945 operations moved to 6423 South Wentworth Avenue, partnership succeeded then by corporation April 1947. Fishman holds 85% of the stock.

The Garfield Steel Co., formerly reported owned by Louis Fishman started in March 1957. June 1957 operations discontinued as sole proprietorship and began as division of subject. Division style discontinued in 1959.

Records of the United States District Court, Chicago, show as of March 30, 1951 Louis Fishman was indicted on charge of attempting to defect and evade large portion of income tax, owing for the year 1944, but on April 27, 1953 the court entered finding of not guilty and the defendant discharged, Docket #51C-1551.

Marilyn Fishman, native born 1914. Devotes her time to household duties, not active here.

In November 1959, Jordan S. Fishman, son of president, succeeded Samuel Z. Sostrin as president.

Jordan S. Fishman, 24, married, native born. Has been active here since 1958. From 1954 to 1958, he attended the University of Illinois.
