Enclosed please find an application for workers' compensation benefits we received from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. We would like you to represent us in this matter, if you are willing. You have been highly recommended by Janet Charzelewski of Self-Insurers Service.

You will note on the Hearing Notice that there is reference to "No Insurance". Please advise the Bureau of Workers' Compensation that Contract Transportation Systems is a wholly owned subsidiary of the Sherwin-Williams Company. We have been self-insured since January 1, 1986, our certificate number is 1280. I trust you will be able to resolve this matter for us.

Regarding the circumstances of the death, I cannot add to or provide any additional information at this time. The receipt of the application for workers' compensation benefits has taken us by surprise. However, I have taken steps to obtain all pertaining documents such as prior medical records, personnel file, and any vehicle maintenance information to help resolve this claim.
