I am presently dealing with a claim presented by one of our employees who alleges he has been poisoned by the fumes emanating from Ethyl Gasoline in a pumping engine.

This claimant alleges that he has contracted pulmonary tuberculosis over a period of years through remaining inside a building where the pumping engine is located and attributes the cause of his condition to poisoning by Ethyl Gasoline fumes.

I would appreciate very much if you will let me have a report covering the composition of Ethyl Gasoline and an opinion if Ethyl Gasoline fumes could really cause such a condition. I understand from one of your representatives in Montreal that your Medical Department is in a position to supply this information which would enable me to complete my investigation into this matter.
