Dear Morton:

Per our telephone conversation of April 17, 1969, present plans for UNIBESTOS scrap handling include retaining the Butler Building as a storage receptacle. A feasibility study is in process to determine problems and costs associated with mechanically transferring scrap from the Butler Building to the weigh hoppers above the feeders.

Also, all dust collectors for the mixing area will be located at the south end of Plant 8 (present location of the Nor-Blo unit). Costs of preparing a site on the west side of Plant 8 appear to be too high in relation to the benefits gained.
