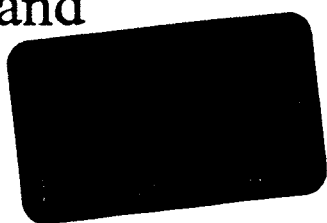

Quote: "The annual report of the Chief Inspector of Factories shows that from 1935 to 1938 inclusive, **deaths from** [silicosis and **asbestosis**] in the refractories industries ... **have been approximately constant...** Preventive measures have aided in a generally small decrease; some of these measures are as follows: (1) use of alumina for flint in china bedding, (2) use of alumina for siliceous material in parting powders, (3) use of nonsiliceous abrasives for sand or flint..., (4) use of nonsiliceous material for kieselguhr ..., and (5) use of nonsiliceous material for silica brick for lining steel and other furnaces." [emphasis added]
