Dear Dr. Kehoe:

I am enclosing you herewith a copy of a letter dated August 26, 1936 which purports to be a report of Dr. Thomas E. Lowe to Mr. G. W. Mercer, attorney for the plaintiff in the case of Mrs. [REDACTED] v. Employers Reinsurance Corporation, concerning which we have just talked. I think it will give you a pretty fair history of this claim.

There is not time to comment, as I am attempting to get this letter on the next airmail, except to say that according to the testimony of Mr. [REDACTED] fellow workmen he had not been at any time prior to his illness subjected to any unusual quantities of gasoline either by the soaking of his clothes or otherwise.

As stated to you in my letter, I will attempt to see what can be done with our docket with a view to getting the case set for a definite date and will advise you promptly as soon as I know more on that subject. In the meantime, should you care to make any comments on the report which is enclosed, I would be very glad to have them either by telephone or by airmail as you think most suitable.

Mr. [REDACTED] was also seen by a Dr. Scott whose statement is also enclosed herewith. Dr. Scott is of the opinion that the man died from food poisoning.
