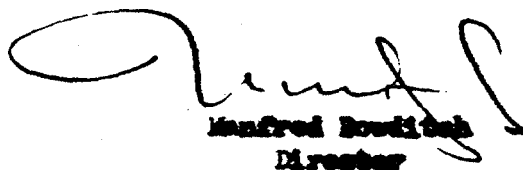
Gentlemen:

On receiving today Mr. Ainsworth's letter of August 16 suggesting September 27 and 28 as days for meetings in connection with the work of the ISV committee, I telephoned his office to suggest that these meetings be held on days immediately following or preceding the annual meeting of the A.P.H.A. which is to be held October 2 - 5 in New York City, in order to save all of us the necessity of two trips to New York on consecutive weeks.

Mr. Ainsworth was away, but his secretary, Miss Cappelletti, told me that October 6 and 7 would be impossible for Mr. Ainsworth, because he would be at the National Safety Conference in Chicago. She said that September 29 and 30 would be quite possible, however, and that the dates as planned could be changed to these if the committee members so desired.
