SUBJECT: Y-2200 LINE -
GLIDDEN OIL HOUSE PAINT CHANGES

We are sending through the following formulas:

1. Y-2216-C Glidden House Paint Barn Red

Lead drier is being replaced by zirconium and cobalt with a cost increase of 2¢ per gallon.

2. Y-2217-H Glidden House Paint Chalking White

This formula goes to Atlanta and Carrollton only and there will be no drier change at this time. The change is to use Nopocide E-451 in place of Vancide E-454 on an equal cost basis.

3. Y-2240-G, G-CH Glidden House Paint Non-Chalking

The Chicago formula will be lead free and also use the new mildewcide E-451. The cost increase will be 2¢ per gallon. The other northern and southern formulas will have no cost increase.

4. Y-2251-E, E-1, Glidden House Paint Primer

Both formulas will be lead-free and will use the new mildewcide E-451 on an equal cost basis. The drier cost is 2¢ per gallon.
