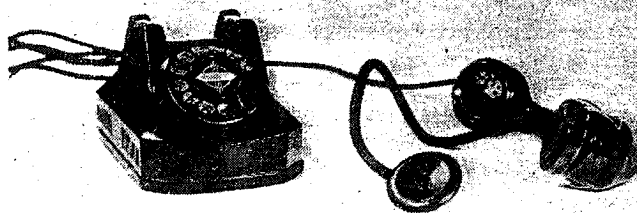


somewhat changed form under the same name, and at the price of \$2.75. (The pre-war unit is priced at \$1.95.)

The gadget is used by snapping one of its two elements over the receiver part of the telephone; a tube of rubberlike material connected with it transmits the sound from the receiver to a smoothly finished disk which is placed against the ear of one of the listeners. The other listener simply uses the telephone in the ordinary way. The arrangement serves to divide the sound received between the two persons listening. Thus both are able to hear the conversation and both can, if desired, participate in it. The gadget fits more easily

on a French-style phone than it does on the old-fashioned receiver; the larger diameter

of the old-type receiver makes the fitting of the *Twinsone* rather difficult.
