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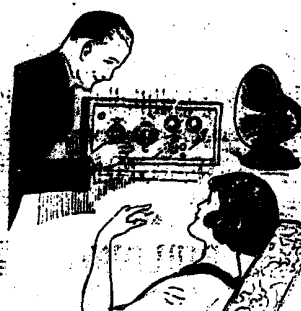

Boxes Enough to House 75,000 People

The nation's hunger for citrus
fruits and apples has grown to the
point where 50,000 wooden boxes
are required each year as con-
sumers, says American Forests
and Forest Life. Those 50,000,000
boxes, if placed end to end, would
reach from New York to San Fran-
cisco and back again three times.
The lumber used in making that
number of boxes would build 15,
000 homes, or sufficient housing
for a city of 75,000 people. Twelve
houses in per cent of all lumber goes to the
lumber-box factories.
